



System Requirements for Passport Business Solutions, PBS Manufacturing and CashPoint

Microsoft Windows Workstations	<i>All Microsoft-supported versions through Windows 11, except Home Edition)</i>
Microsoft Windows Servers	<i>All Microsoft-supported versions through Windows Server 2025</i>
Linux	<i>glibc 2.3.4 or above within the Intel x86 series</i>
Microsoft SQL Server and SSRS	<i>All Microsoft-supported versions through MS SQL Server 2025, including Express, Standard, and Enterprise Editions. *Express versions of SQL Server do not allow scheduled SSRS reporting. SQL Express versions through 2022 are capped at 10 GB across all DBs in the instance. That limit has increased to 50 GB for SQL Express 2025.</i>

Note: PBS Installs as a 32-bit application on a 32 or 64-bit operating system.

PBS v.12.07 and above running on Microsoft Windows workstations and Windows Server require .NET framework v.4.0.30319 or above. Native client 11.0 is required to run PBS SQL.

For RAM requirements, etc. please conform to the minimum requirements or better for the various Microsoft Windows operating systems.

ODBC with AcuXDBC can be used with PBS Vision only. PBS SQL has built-in database connections which do *not* require ODBC.

ODBC Catalog for AcuXDBC Requirements:

- Microsoft Office comes in both 32-bit or 64-bit versions. XDBC comes in both 32-bit and 64-bit version. Microsoft Office and XDBC must match bit versions. If you need to switch from 32 to 64-bit, or vice versa, contact Passport for details.
- Rocket Software, who produces XDBC, supports Office 365 version 9.2.2 and later for Office 365 Pro and Enterprise. 32- and 64-bit versions of Office 365 apply as well.

Microsoft Support Ended for These Environments

- SQL Server 2012 and 2014 are no longer supported by Microsoft. SQL Server 2016 support ended in July 2021 – except Service Pack 2 which has Extended support that ends in July 2026. SQL Server 2019 mainstream support ended in February 2025 with critical security updates only until October 2029, with extended support until October 2034.
- Support for Windows 7 ended in January of 2020.
- Support for Windows 8.1 ended in January of 2023.
- Support for Windows 10 ended in October of 2025. Extended Security Updates (ESU) available through October 2027.
